## Residents' Right to VOTE

## Election Day – Wednesday, November 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2020

Residents of long-term care facilities have the right to vote, even with the Covid-19 pandemic.

It is important to be informed of ways that facilities can assist with the voting process.

## If you need help, facility staff may:

- Assist you in registering to vote.
- Help you to make sure your voter registration is up-to-date.
- ➤ Help you assess whether and how you may need help to prepare and participate in the voting process.
- ➤ Help you decide whether you will vote by mail-in ballot or absentee ballot.
- Assist you with obtaining a mail-in ballot OR absentee ballot.
- Assist you to mark your ballot to reflect your choices.
- Assist you in locating a FREE notary <a href="https://www.sos.mo.gov/elections/MailinNotary">https://www.sos.mo.gov/elections/MailinNotary</a> if you choose to vote by mail-in ballot.

## **Facility staff may not:**

- ➤ Apply for a mail-in ballot for you without your knowledge as your signature is required.
- > Attempt to influence your vote.
- Mark a ballot in a way other than instructed by you.
- > Tell anyone how you voted.
- Vote on your behalf without your knowledge.
